FOUNDATION STAGE

The activities cover many areas of learning, in particular knowledge and understanding of the world.

What a 'Sensation'

An exploration of the school grounds using different senses. This programme includes a variety of practical experiential activities including colour, texture, sound, smell and close observation in the natural environment.

The Snail Trail

Children will use the story of the 'Snail Trail' to stimulate a morning of activities and investigations into snails and other minibeasts. The themes of camouflage, predation and protection will be explored.

The Crunching Munching Caterpillar

The children will use the story of the 'Crunching Munching Caterpillar' to stimulate a morning of activities and investigations into caterpillars and butterflies. The themes of lifecycles, feeding and senses will be explored.

The Dandelion Seed

The children will use the story of 'The Dandelion Seed' to stimulate a morning of activities and investigations into plants and seeds. The themes of growing and seed dispersal will be explored.
